



How it works

1 To initiate a prescription, (1) your doctor will complete and sign the right side of the enrollment form, and (2) you will complete and sign the left side

Enroll in 2 simple steps

2 Your doctor faxes the enrollment form to the Mission Rx Support Program. Refills do not require additional enrollment forms

3 The Mission Rx Support Program contacts your insurance company to determine co-pay and any limitations on prescribing. If you don't have insurance, options will be discussed with you

4 The Mission Rx Support Program contacts you to confirm your insurance, collect co-pay, and arrange shipping

The Mission Program completes the process and delivers directly to you

5 The Mission Rx Support Program processes claim with your insurance provider

6 The Mission Rx Support Program ships BINOSTO® (alendronate sodium) effervescent tablet for oral solution 70 mg directly to your home

7 The Mission Rx Support Program sends your doctor shipping confirmation

What is the Mission Rx Support Program?

The Mission Rx Support Program is a FREE prescription service that provides valuable assistance with your insurance coverage and delivers BINOSTO® (alendronate sodium) effervescent tablet for oral solution 70 mg directly to your front door at no additional cost other than your co-pay.

How does the Mission Rx Support Program work?

Your health care professional will ask you to complete and sign an enrollment form while you are in the office. It's very important that your name and phone number are legible so the Mission Rx Support Program can get in touch with you.

A Mission Program customer service representative will contact your insurance company to determine the details of your coverage and co-pay.

Once that happens, you will receive a telephone call in 1 to 2 days from a Mission Program representative to discuss your insurance, options for payment, and delivery.

If you don't have insurance, the Mission Program representatives will discuss your options with you.

So I don't need to go to a pharmacy to pick up my prescription?

That's where the convenience comes in. No errand to the retail pharmacy is required. We've found that pharmacies and insurance companies sometimes substitute generic pills for BINOSTO® (alendronate sodium) effervescent tablet for oral solution 70 mg. Your health care professional has prescribed BINOSTO for you based on clinical efficacy and safety, and with the Mission Rx Support Program, pharmacy substitution is avoided.

How can the Mission Rx Support Program help with my insurance coverage?

The Mission Rx Support Program is your personal advocate when it comes to your insurance coverage. If BINOSTO is covered and you have a co-pay, you need only pay your regular amount. If BINOSTO is not covered, you don't have insurance, or there are steps you need to take (like trying a generic drug) before you can take BINOSTO, the Mission Program representatives will discuss your options with you.

Can I get refills through the Mission Rx Support Program?

Of course. Your health care professional can authorize refills on the original enrollment form. You will receive a reminder 7 days in advance of the next month's refill.

Do I have to participate in the Mission Rx Support Program?

Absolutely not. You can have your prescription filled the traditional way. Also, if you enter the program and decide later that you want to stop, you can opt out at any time by calling the Mission Rx Support Program Customer Service TOLL-FREE at 1-866-694-2553.

My doctor gave me a \$60 coupon for BINOSTO® (alendronate sodium) effervescent tablet for oral solution 70 mg. Can I still use it?

Of course. The Mission Rx Support Program will apply the coupon for all eligible patients.* Restrictions may apply.

1. The coupon is not valid for prescriptions purchased under Medicaid, Medicare, TRICARE, Federal, or state programs (including any state prescription drug programs), or private indemnity or HMO insurance plans which reimburse you for the entire cost of your prescription drugs.
